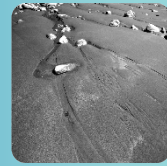

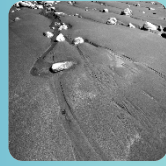

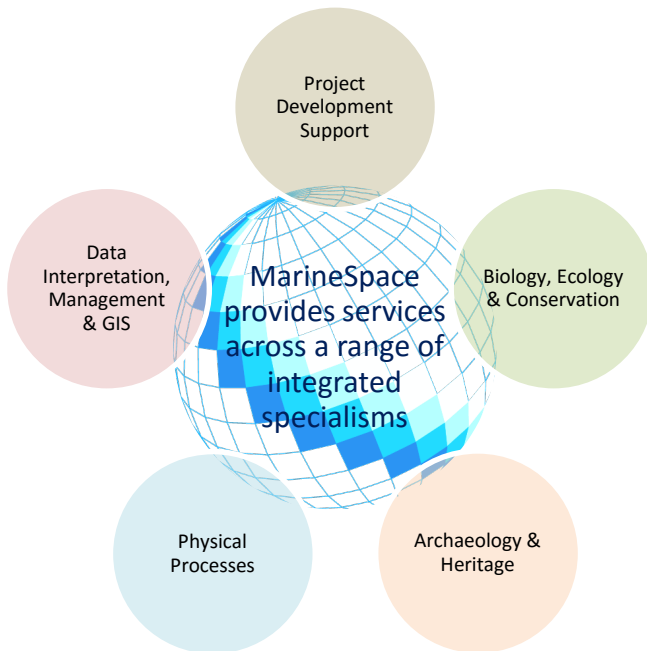

Project Case Study

MarineSpace acted as the Agent of The Crown Estate regarding the monitoring and reporting of beneficial use of maintenance dredge spoil in Lymington Harbour.

As part of the consent conditions related to the building of the breakwaters, Lymington Harbour were required to undertake a habitat replenishment scheme on an area of saltmarsh that will be sheltered behind the breakwaters. The main aim of the replenishment scheme was to use sediment dredged during maintenance of Lymington Yacht Haven to raise the level of an area of intertidal mud within the saltmarsh in order to further increase the level of certainty that the breakwaters will not have a significant effect on the protected habitat.

As part of its Stewardship role and in fulfilment of its public body duty with regard to biodiversity, The Crown Estate has recently grant-aided the second phase of the saltmarsh habitat replenishment scheme for the Lymington Harbour Commissioners. MarineSpace completed the summary of the implementation of the scheme, and the initial results were included in a report to The Crown Estate, which has now been published.
